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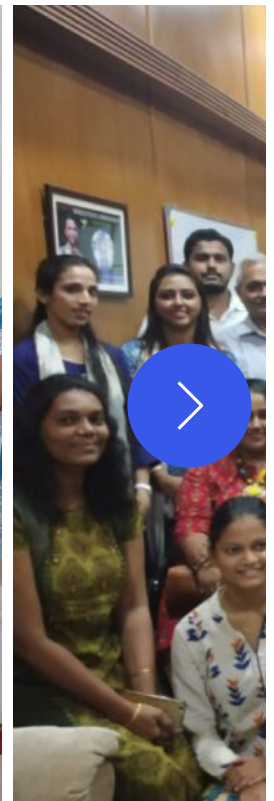

Second Assignment : Participants will have to choose the topic from list of current issues and have to submit for critical evaluation. (2000 words - 100 marks)

Field Visits: Participants will be required to visit Organizations involved in Human Rights issues and present a Field Visit Report. (100 marks)

To receive the Certificate, a candidate must secure 60% of marks in all three components of the course as well as have an attendance of 75%. (including field visit)

ELIGIBILITY

A bachelor's degree in any discipline.

DURATION

The duration of the course is three months.
