3. **Field Visits**: Participants will be required to visit Organizations involved in Human Rights issues and present an Assessment Report of the Visit. (800 words / 50 marks)

To qualify for the Certificate, a candidate must obtain a minimum 45% of marks in all three components of evaluation as well as have an attendance of 75%. (including field visit)

### **ELIGIBILITY**

A bachelor's degree in any discipline.

### **DURATION**

The duration of the course is three months.

### **FEEES**

The entire course fee is Rs.6000/- per participant and Rs.100/- for the prospects & Application form. The fee once deposited will not be refunded. Fees can be paid by Cash or D.D. in favor of
