Step for Anti Ragging form

5. Open the Official Portal

Go to antiragging.in

On the homepage, you will see options like “Fill Undertaking”, “Download Undertaking”, etc.

6. Select “Fill Undertaking”

Click this option to open the online form. You’ll need to fill details such as:

Student’s name, address, date of birth

College name, course, year of study

Parent/guardian’s details

7. Fill the Form and Submit

Enter all the required information carefully and click Submit.

Once submitted, the system will generate a PDF version of your affidavit (undertaking).

8. Download the PDF Affidavit

The affidavit will appear on your screen and will also be sent to your registered email.

Download it and take a printout.

APAAR ID Generation Process

7. Visit the Official Portal

Open: <https://abc.gov.in>

Click “Student” → “Create ABC ID”.

8. Login via DigiLocker

You will be redirected to the DigiLocker login page.

Enter the mobile number linked with your Aadhaar.

Login using the OTP received.

9. Aadhaar Authentication

Enter your Aadhaar number and verify with OTP.

Your basic details will be fetched automatically from UIDAI.

10. Fill in Additional Details

Add your email ID and mobile number (if not already filled).

Enter your institution/college details.

11. Submit the Form

Review all details carefully.

Click Submit to generate your APAAR ID / ABC ID instantly.

12. Save Your APAAR ID

Download the PDF card or note down the APAAR ID (a unique alphanumeric code).

Use this ID for all academic records and admissions.

Note:

Aadhaar must be linked with your mobile number.

Once generated, the APAAR ID is valid for a lifetime.
