Admission process for only students of GLC,
Outsider students are not allowed.

This admission process is exclusively for the students of Government Law College, Mumbai. Students from any other college are not eligible to participate in this admission process.

The In-House Online Admission Process for the Third Year of the Three-Year LL.B. Course and the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Years of the Five-Year LL.B. Course for the Academic Year 2026–2027 will commence from 03:00 p.m. on 04th July 2026.

Students are required to click on the admission portal link provided below and complete the online admission application form. Students must ensure that all information furnished in the application form is true, accurate, and complete.

After verification of the information and documents uploaded by the applicants, the College Administration will publish the Provisional Admission List on the College website. Inclusion in the provisional list is subject to satisfactory verification of the information and documents submitted. **All admissions shall remain subject to final verification and approval by the College.**

Ex-students & Old Students seeking admission are required to remain personally present at the College on or before 10th July 2026, along with their original marksheet and permission letter, to complete the admission process.

All students must submit their admission form and pay the prescribed admission fee on or before 5:00 p.m. on 10th July 2026. No admission shall be granted under any circumstances after the prescribed deadline.

The In-House Admission Eligibility Criteria are enclosed herewith. Only students who satisfy the prescribed eligibility criteria should submit the admission form. If an ineligible student submits the application, furnishes incorrect information, or fills the admission form incorrectly, the responsibility shall rest solely with the concerned student.

If such an application is rejected by the College, the admission fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

ADMISSION PROCESS – DOCUMENT SUBMISSION

GUIDELINES

Documents Required for All Students:

1. All Semester Results/Gazette Copy (PDF format):
2. Recent Passport Size Photograph and Signature (JPG Format)
3. Fee Receipt or College ID Card (PDF format)

Additional Documents (If Applicable):

1. Caste Certificate (for Reserved Category students)
2. EWS Certificate (for EWS category students)
3. Income Certificate (for EWS and OBC category students)
4. Disability Certificate (for students with physical/any disability)

Note:

- All documents must be clearly scanned and in PDF format. These documents will be required to be uploaded during the admission process.
- If any fee is paid based on false information or incorrect documents, strict action will be taken against the individual, and a penalty of double the original fee, in addition to the actual amount, will be charged.
- If you availed a fee concession last year and failed to fill the MAHADBT form for that academic year despite multiple notifications published by the college on the website, you will be required to pay the remaining admission fee for that year. In such a case, you are advised to contact the college immediately. Otherwise, a penalty of double the original fee, in addition to the actual amount, will be charged.



Eligibility For In-House Admission

Students are advised to carefully read the eligibility criteria mentioned on the website before proceeding with admission.

Students who have failed in more than three subjects will not be eligible for admission.

For the Five-Year Law Course:

- Students seeking admission to the Third Year must have passed all subjects of the First Year.
- Students seeking admission to the Fourth Year must have passed all subjects of the First and Second Year.
- Students seeking admission to the Final Year (Fifth Year) must have passed all subjects of the First, Second, and Third Year.

For the Three-Year Law Course:

- Students seeking admission to the Third Year must have passed all subjects of the First Year. Otherwise, they will not be eligible for the admission process.
- Further, if a student has failed or remained absent in internal subjects, such subjects will be treated as KT/FAIL.

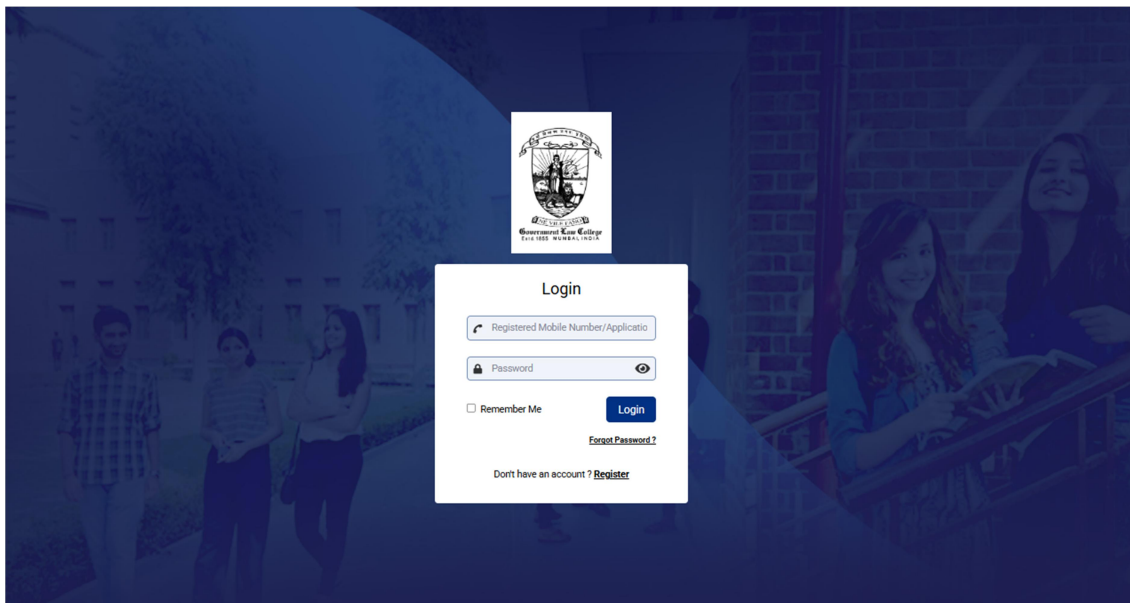
