Topics of Assignment:

Write **any two** of the following—

3. State different modes of searching a case law.
4. What are the External Aids used in the interpretation of statutes?

Instructions for Assignment submission:

1. The assignment shall be handwritten. Visually impaired students may submit typed assignment or may take help of scribe.
2. Page- A4 or full scape, Margins: 2 inches from Left and 1 inch from Right, Top and Bottom, word limit: min. 600 words for each answer (total min.1200 words)
3. Sources/references shall be mentioned either in footnotes or endnotes in uniform citation and reference pattern.
4. Pages of assignment must be stapled properly or in spiral binding. Do NOT submit assignment in loose pages in file or folder.
5. Add cover page to the assignment mentioning Full Name, Seat No., Class, Division, Subject and a Table of Topics with page no. Assignments submitted without above details won't be accepted and assessed.
6. Kindly, note that late submissions shall NOT be accepted under any circumstances.
7. **Viva** will be conducted on the topics written in assignment on the same day.
